We thank Chairman Langerholc and the Transportation committee for beginning the 2023-24 legislative session by building on past momentum towards a sustainable, comprehensive funding system for transportation and infrastructure. As we compare our position versus other states who are gaining population and have better rankings for economic competitiveness, the quality of our infrastructure is paramount to the success of our economy and the safety of our residents.
