I write on behalf of the PA Chamber regarding House Bill 1364, which would fund public transit by increasing the amount of existing sales tax revenue transferred to the Public Transportation Trust Fund. We appreciate the committee's focus on a key PA Chamber priority and hope the conversation surrounding this legislation encourages progress towards a comprehensive transportation infrastructure and funding agreement.

The PA Chamber supports public transit, which is critical for many employers across the state by providing their employees the opportunity to access employment, as well as educational opportunities, healthcare, and a wide range of community activities.
