On behalf of the Pennsylvania Chamber of Business and Industry (PA Chamber), representing nearly 10,000 member companies of all sizes from across all commercial and industrial sectors, I am writing to express our **support for Senate Bills 333 and 444**, which are scheduled for final passage before the Senate today.

As businesses consider investing and expanding in the Commonwealth, one of the most significant challenges they face is navigating Pennsylvania's complex and often burdensome regulatory and permitting process. Businesses across industries cite delays, uncertainty, and inconsistent requirements as major obstacles that make Pennsylvania less competitive compared to other states.

Addressing these challenges is essential to attracting new investment, fostering innovation, and supporting long-term economic growth. Senate Bills 333 and 444 aim to increase regulatory transparency, accountability, and flexibility, which are key steps in addressing these challenges and enhancing Pennsylvania's economic competitiveness.

Senate Bill 333 (Keefer) and **Senate Bill 444 (Brooks)** represent a thoughtful and balanced approach to regulatory reform in Pennsylvania. SB 333 strengthens legislative oversight by requiring any economically significant regulation with an annual impact of \$1 million or more, to receive approval from the General Assembly before taking effect. SB 444 complements this by requiring such regulations to be reviewed every three years to assess their ongoing effectiveness and relevance. Together, these measures promote accountability, encourage innovation, and help ensure that high-impact regulations support economic growth while maintaining essential protections.

It is for these reasons that we urge to **support Senate Bills 333 and 444** on final passage.
