RE: **PA Chamber memo: Oppose H.B. 64 - Workplace meetings**

The PA Chamber opposes H.B. 64, which the Committee is scheduled to consider next week.

H.B. 64 is described as a bill to prohibit employers from requiring employees to attend a meeting that “involves the employer expressing their views on political or religious matters.”

Unfortunately, the language of the bill shows it is in fact another attempt in a decades-long effort to restrict employers from communicating with their people during a union organizing campaign.

Pennsylvanians being solicited to join a union deserve the benefit of multiple perspectives to assess the impact on their finances, careers, and workplace. Accordingly, we urge you to oppose this bill.
