RE: **PA Chamber memo: Amend H.B. 1522 - Fuel Gas Detector Act**

The PA Chamber urges you to hold off consideration of H.B. 1522, known as the Fuel Gas Detector Act, which the House may consider today.

The bill requires the installation of natural gas alarms in businesses, residences, and other buildings and mandates penalties for noncompliance.

We appreciate the intent; however, many questions have been raised by employers including related to applicability, enforcement, unequal application of liability protections, the potential for new private rights of action, among other areas. Unfortunately, amendments recommended by the PA Chamber to provide necessary clarity have not been considered. We urge you to hold off consideration until important questions and concerns are addressed.
