RE: **PA Chamber memo: Support HB 2469 - Empowering Local P3 Opportunities**

I write on behalf of the PA Chamber of Business and Industry in support of House Bill 2469, which would expand and clarify the ability of local governments to utilize public-private partnerships to deliver transportation projects. This bill is scheduled for consideration by the House Transportation Committee this morning.

HB 2469 expands the ability of counties and major municipalities to collaborate with the private sector on the design, financing, construction, and maintenance of transportation infrastructure. Public private partnerships (P3s) can accelerate project delivery, encourage innovation, and make efficient use of public resources. This added flexibility allows local governments to explore innovative financing and project delivery methods to address pressing infrastructure needs more efficiently within the P3 review structure currently in place. Expanding P3 opportunities creates new avenues for private sector participation while accelerating project timelines and improving infrastructure quality.
