RE: **PA Chamber memo: Support H.B. 2214 - County Bridge Funding Distribution**

I write on behalf of the PA Chamber of Business and Industry in support of House Bill 2214, which is slated for consideration today in the House Transportation Committee.

HB 2214 strengthens the distribution of transportation funding needed to maintain and improve county and municipal bridge infrastructure and ensures that all local governments are included in the allocation process. This legislation directs existing transportation revenues to better reflect infrastructure conditions and provides counties flexibility to address bridge maintenance needs across local systems. Well maintained bridges are essential to maintaining efficient supply chains, supporting workforce mobility, and ensuring safe access to markets, jobs, essential services, and recreation.
