RE: **PA Chamber memo: Support HB 2266 - Modernizing the Highway Transfer Turnback Program**

I write on behalf of the PA Chamber of Business and Industry regarding House Bill 2266, which is on the agenda for consideration today in the House Transportation Committee. The PA Chamber supports this legislation as an important update to the Highway Transfer “Turnback” Program.

HB 2266 modernizes the Highway Transfer “Turnback” program by updating maintenance payments to municipalities and incorporating inflationary adjustments so that funding keeps pace with actual costs. These updates provide greater predictability and fairness for local governments that have assumed responsibility for maintaining former state roads and will encourage more municipalities to participate in the program. Encouraging local stewardship of roadways supports efficient asset management and allows state transportation resources to remain focused on major corridors critical to statewide commerce.
