RE: **PA Chamber memo: Support HB 2186 & 2109 - Expanding Housing Options**

I write on behalf of the PA Chamber to urge support for H.B. 2186 & 2109. We understand these bills may be considered this week.

H.B. 2186 streamlines the process for creating accessory dwelling units such as in law suites and garage apartments, while H.B. 2109, the Golden Girls Act, allows greater flexibility for shared housing arrangements among unrelated adults.

Employers across the Commonwealth continue to face workforce challenges, and housing is a growing part of the problem. Affordability constraints and limited options near job centers make it harder to attract and retain workers. By increasing attainable housing choices and making better use of existing homes, these bills help support workforce participation and economic growth.

The PA Chamber supports H.B. 2186 and H.B. 2109 as practical steps to expand housing options and address Pennsylvania's housing shortage while recognizing that additional changes may be necessary as the legislative process continues and encourage ongoing discussions with stakeholders to strengthen the proposals..
