RE: **PA Chamber memo: Hold Off S.B. 908 – Prevailing Wage**

The PA Chamber urges the Senate to hold off consideration of S.B. 908 expanding Prevailing Wage and provide time and a process for lawmakers and the public to understand the impact.

We appreciate the bill has been amended to remove the “split-rate” prohibition; however, we still have serious concerns with expanding prevailing wage requirements to work that occurs outside the worksite.

This represents a significant policy shift with substantial implications on public constructions costs, taxpayers, and employers and all stakeholders should have the opportunity to at least understand the impact of the bill and share concerns.
