RE: **PA Chamber memo: Oppose SB 908 – Prevailing Wage Act Amendments**

The PA Chamber opposes S.B. 908 expanding the PA Prevailing Wage Act. The Committee is scheduled to consider the bill today.

The PA Prevailing Wage Act requires state-determined wages be paid to employees on public construction projects and S.B. 908 proposes significant amendments, including applying the law to fabrication work that occurs separate from the worksite and prohibiting the practice of paying “split rates” which employers utilize to promote flexibility and efficiency and mitigate costs on taxpayers.
